APPLICATION DETAILS

- Apply online via the Jamboree Application System as a participant and select "Day Worker" on the Job/Skills Tab. Go to <https://applications.aj2016.com.au>
- Day workers can attend up to 6 days onsite or 8 days at the offsite activities (Water and City Sights) from 4th – 12th January. Days can be non-consecutive and you go home at night.
- A \$20 administration fee covers your application costs and a \$10 daily fee covers you for one meal a day plus a hat. A scarf and badge will be provided to those helping for more than 3 days
- To qualify you must be an adult member of Scouts (Leader, Rover or [Adult Helper](#)) with a current Working with Children Check.
