ELIGIBILITY

Scout	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be a registered Scout Section member at the time of application• Have been awarded the Pioneer badge• Have completed ten (10) nights under canvas as a Scout, at a Scout camp, with three (3) of those nights being consecutive• Have approval from the Scouts' Scout Leader (or Leader-In-Charge)• Have approval from the Branch Commissioner, Scouts• Have approval from the Contingent Leader• Have consent from their parents/guardian• Not have had their 15th birthday before the opening day of the Jamboree
Venturer	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be registered as a Venturer Scout• Be 16 years of age before the opening day of the Jamboree, and should not have reached their 18 years by the end of the Jamboree• Have completed the Venturing Skills Award• Have a desire to provide service to Scouts• Have recommended by the Unit Council as being of excellent character, a good role model to Scouts and has the skills and abilities to undertake the activity (or other tasks) nominated on the application form• Have approval from the Contingent Leader• Have consent from parents/guardian
Rover	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be registered as a Rover• Be recommended by his/her Crew Leader as being of excellent character, a good role model to Scouts and has the skills and abilities to undertake the activity (or other tasks) nominated on the application form• Be approved by his/her Contingent Leader in line with their Branch policy
Leader	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hold a Certificate of Adult Leadership• Must have completed Wood Badge Training prior to the Jamboree including Child Safe Environments• Must be willing to act in any role in which the Contingent Leader considers you are most suited
Other Adult	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adults must complete and satisfy a police check in accordance with current Branch Adult Membership Application Procedure• Must be willing to act in any role in which the Contingent Leader considers you are most suited

Scout applicants are reminded that attendance at a Jamboree is a privilege and not a right. There are certain behavioural standards that will be monitored over the period from point of application acceptance to final application approval date to ascertain attendance

If completing the hard copy version, please complete all parts of the application and attach 2 copies of a passport photo. All hard copy forms received by the Contingent will be entered into the Jamboree system by the Contingent.
