## WELCOME...

Welcome to Super Saturday at the 24<sup>th</sup> Australian Jamboree. Super Saturday consists of 3 components which are:

- Market Day
- Future Scout Day
- Visitors Day

Scouts will be running Market Day activities for other Scouts and Future Scouts (Joey & Cub Scouts) to participate in. These will be run over 2 sessions:

- Morning - 9:30am to 11:30am - Even numbered troops (eg A102, C524, etc) running stalls, odd numbered troops spending their Jam Dollars
- Afternoon - 2:00pm to 4:00pm - Odd numbered troops (eg A207, D715, etc) running stalls, even numbered troops spending their Jam Dollars

Those of you who purchased Future Scout Day Packs will get an allocation of Jam Dollars (Jamboree money) to spend at the Market Day activities. If you don't have any Jam Dollars we still encourage you to enjoy the spectacle of the Market Day activities.

Future Scout Day Packs are available for collection from the Bus Terminal (as marked on the map). Please make your way to the bus terminal to collect your pack with lots of goodies including Jam Dollars to spend at the exciting Market Day activities.

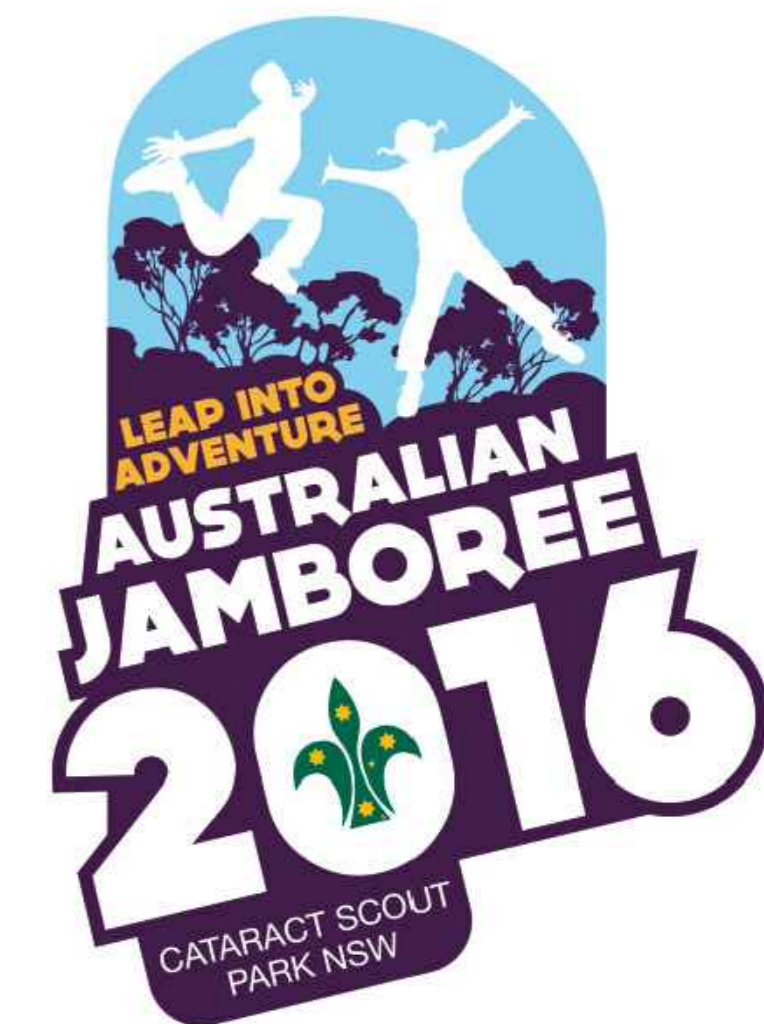
## FINDING YOUR SCOUT...

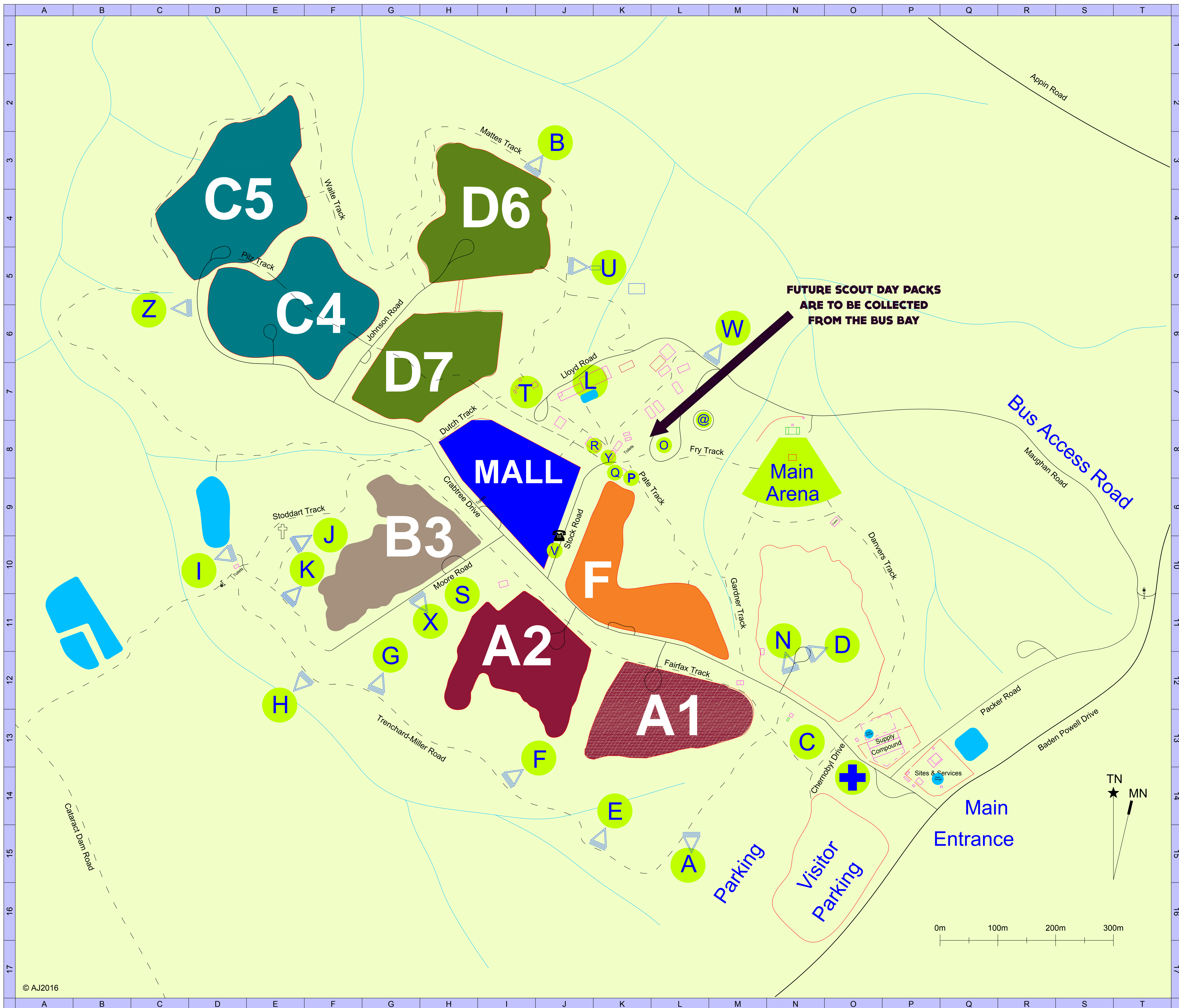
